Peace of Mind for Carers


BriteCare ensures faster intervention in an emergency. With real time alerts for falls and other anomalies bringing peace of mind and safety assurance for both carers and people in need.


Expanding Social Care Capacity

At Home




BriteZone Wearable

While outside, the wearable will continue to report information to the carer.




BriteZone User App
